About us	Saam Theatre Company has been founded by Soussan Farrokhnia and Mostafa Shafafi on Nov 2000. Later Sahba Ladjevardi on 2006 joined them to run the company.
Saam House	In 2002 Soussan Farrokhnia decided to create an environment for performing arts. She risked her personal finance to create this Studio and called this Saam House. Despite its great success, Saam House had to be closed down in 2005 because it was located in residential area.
